Population climbs 10% in Cedar Park

Cedar Park's latest population charts have been compiled and show the city saw its growth jump.

Cedar Park's population increased 10.5 percent in 2007, compared with 6 percent in 2006. The city's population now stands at about 50,000 people. In its extraterritorial jurisdiction, the city grew 9.5 percent in 2007 compared with a 3 percent growth rate in the previous year. That population now stands at about 22,500.

The 10 percent growth jump isn't a record for the city. In 2005, the city grew by 13 percent inside its city limits and in 1995 population jumped 45 percent inside city limits.

According to the city planning department's projections, Cedar Park's population will grow to about 68,000 by 2015.

Cedar Park is located about 30 miles northwest of Austin.
