Dell secures \$42M Army contract

Dell Perot Systems was awarded a \$42 million, five-year contract to provide services to the **U.S. Army Rock Island Arsenal** in Illinois, officials said today.

Dell Perot's Virginia-based government services business unit, which was acquired in November by Round Rock-based **Dell Inc.** (Nasdaq: DELL), will provide command, control, communications, computer and information management services.

The unit has run services at the Rock Island Arsenal for four years, officials said.

Dell Inc. established Dell Services and Dell Perot Systems last year after it acquired Plano-based **Perot Systems Corp.** for \$3.9 billion, the largest acquisition in Dell's history. Perot Systems provides information technology services.

Dell, the No. 3 computer maker in the world, employs 16,000 workers in Central Texas.
