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## TWO COMPANIES EXPANDING, JOBS TO COME

SAN ANTONIO ([San Antonio Express-News](#)) – Two companies with operations in the Alamo City are up for tax abatements to help with the construction of new facilities and relocation of their offices.

Glazer's Distributors, a distributor of wine and spirits, plans to invest \$26 million to construct a marketing and distribution facility near Port San Antonio. The Dallas-based company would add 103 jobs to its 131-person San Antonio workforce over the next four years.

The company plans to build a 250,000-sf facility on a 35-acre site at SH 151 and South Callaghan Rd. that the city agreed to sell for \$1.5 million. The new building will be LEED certified, according to David Marques, the county's executive director of economic development.

The city council has approved a ten-year, 100 percent tax abatement valued at about \$1.5 million for Glazer's. Bexar County Commissioners Court will consider offering a ten-year, 40 percent tax abatement on real and personal property valued at \$236,950.

Con-way Freight, a logistics company, plans to create 56 jobs by the end of 2015 as part of an \$8.5 million expansion and relocation to the Cornerstone Business Park at 1511 Cornerway Blvd. Northern California-based Con-way is currently at 5685 FM 1346.

The Commissioners Court will consider offering a ten-year, 40 percent tax abatement valued at \$100,700 for Con-way. The city council will consider approving a six-year, 35 percent abatement and economic development grant with a combined value of \$178,400.
