MetroRail now set to launch March 30

The revised date has been set for the launch of the MetroRail line: March 30.

Capital Metro announced the new launch date on Wednesday after the transportation authority's board met to evaluate progress. The commuter rail was supposed to begin service this year but construction delays with two of the line's stops along with delays on the route's signal system prompted Capital Metro to push back the launch.

The 32-mile route runs from Leander to downtown Austin with nine stops along the way.
