



PROJECTS REV UP AT BERGSTROM

AUSTIN ([San Antonio Business Journal](#)) – Satterfield & Pontikes Construction Inc. has been awarded a multimillion federal project at Austin-Bergstrom International Airport.

The Texas Adjutant General's Department awarded the firm a \$41.5 million contract to build a new Armed Forces Reserve Center and joint Vehicle Maintenance Facility at Austin-Bergstrom. The reserve center includes a 209,128-sf facility with an assembly hall, commercial kitchen, classrooms and unit storage with arm vaults. The maintenance facility will accommodate vehicle maintenance bays, tool and supply storage in a 45,830-sf building.

Corpus Christi-based Turner Ramirez & Associates Inc. is project architect. The development will sit on 60 acres at Austin-Bergstrom and will be outfitted with anti-terrorism and force protection measures.

The project is slated to be completed 540 days after work begins in early 2011.

The firm was previously awarded contracts to build medical, housing and training facilities at [Fort Sam Houston](#) and Lackland Air Force Base in San Antonio.
