ROUND ROCK — Round Rock ISD will break ground on Elsa England Elementary School, its 33rd elementary school, on Oct. 20 at 10 a.m.

The new school will be located east of Parmer Lane and just south of Avery Ranch Road. Click on the map at left for a larger map.

The new school will have a capacity of 900 students and is scheduled to open in fall 2012.

According to a news release issued by the district, the school is named after the mother of the landowner who sold the land to the district. England also worked for RRISD.

The release also said the school's construction cost was budgeted at \$26.1 million to be funded by Proposition 1 from the 2008 bond program.
