Catellus laying infrastructure for more homes at Mueller development

The Mueller development will soon see infrastructure for new homes.

Catellus Development Group, the master developer for Mueller redevelopment, is moving forward this summer with road construction and utility installation to prepare lots for an additional 360 homes. The first phase of homebuilding, coming to an end now, included plans for 348 homes. Catellus representatives say most of those 348 homes are complete and occupied or under construction.

"The success of Mueller's first residential phase has exceeded high expectations set by the builders, our team and the community," says Matt Whelan, senior vice president of Catellus.

The development will also begin pre-leasing its first apartments this summer, and lofts will become available later this year.

Six homebuilders -- **David Weekley Homes**, **Meritage Homes**, The Muskin Company, Saldaña Homes, **Standard Pacific Homes** and **Streetman Homes** -- are building houses in the development.
