Round Rock ranks among best family towns

Round Rock was picked as one of the nation's top 10 town's for families, according to *Family Circle* magazine.

The national publication chose communities with ample affordable housing, good neighbors, green spaces, strong public school systems and giving spirits. Other winners include Edmond, Okla.; Hampton Township, Penn.; Edwardsville, Ill.; La Verne, Calif.; Windsor, Colo.; Simpsonville, S.C.; Bristol, RI; Meridian, Idaho; and Bettendorf, Iowa.

Using data from New York research firm Onboard Informatics, *Family Circle* analyzed 1,700 cities with populations between 15,000 and 150,000. Towns were then narrowed down to locations with median incomes of about \$75,000.

“We’ve known for years that Round Rock is a special place for families to call home, so it is an honor to be recognized by such a popular national publication,” Round Rock Mayor Alan McGraw said. “I am proud to live in Round Rock with good neighbors and an unmistakable giving spirit.”
