

# Southern half of SH 130 to open

**State Highway 130 will see its last Austin segment open April 30, completing the 49-mile toll road's path from north of Georgetown to U.S. Highway 183 at Mustang Ridge.**

The completion of Segment 4 means drivers can avoid I-35 to loop around Central Austin, and for some cities in Williamson County, means unprecedented ability to access **Austin-Bergstrom International Airport** without using I-35.

Segment 4 of SH 130 will eventually connect to Texas 45 Southeast when that project is completed in early 2009. For now drivers can connect between SH 130's southern end and I-35 by using FM 1327.

Still to be built are Segments 5 and 6, which will be completed through a public-private partnership between the **Texas Department of Transportation** and Cintra-Zachry. Those sections will stretch 40 miles from Mustang Ridge to I-10 in Seguin.
