Seton administrators move into Mueller

The **Seton Family of Hospitals** celebrated the relocation of its administration offices to East Austin today.

The building, which now houses some 700 Seton administration staffers, is located in the Mueller development at 1345 Philomena St., just south of Seton's Dell Children's Medical Center of Central Texas. Seton runs several hospitals and clinics in the Austin area.

Charles Barnett, Seton's president and CEO, said consolidating the company's administrative staff "creates opportunities for [Seton] to serve more patients in our existing clinical spaces and puts us in the prime location to best serve the region as it continues to grow."

The vacated spaced at Seton Medical Center Austin near 38th Street and North Lamar Boulevard will be used to accommodate patients.

The event was attended by Matt Whelan, senior vice president of the **Catellus Development Group**; Wilhelmina Delco, former Texas Representative; and Rep. Eddie Rodriguez, D-Austin.

"Adding one of Austin's most notable corporate citizens to the eastside community is a huge boost to the ongoing revitalization of the area," Rodriguez said.

Catellus developed and owns the 150,000-square-foot building, which is seeking gold standard LEED [Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design] certification, and is now leasing it back to Seton.
